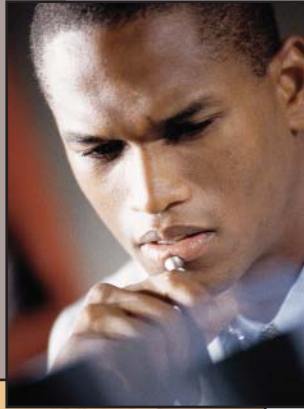

All undereducated New Yorkers without a high school credential or lacking English proficiency will access high quality instruction that addresses their needs and educational goals.

Staff development is provided to each adult educator to improve the practitioner's skills in order to meet or exceed the statewide benchmarks on the National Reporting System's (NRS) core indicators.

Local adult literacy programs will implement program improvement efforts that set performance standards, establish internal data monitoring, enhance data collection procedures and use NRS to refine instructional approaches.

Adult education coalitions will be developed and maintained in each workforce investment area.

### Mission

To provide the leadership and support to adult education and family literacy programs that prepare out-of school youth and adults to carry out their roles as workers, parents, family members, citizens and community participants.

### Vision

Every New Yorker will be literate and possess the knowledge and skills necessary to compete in a global economy, to exercise the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, and to be involved in his or her children's education.

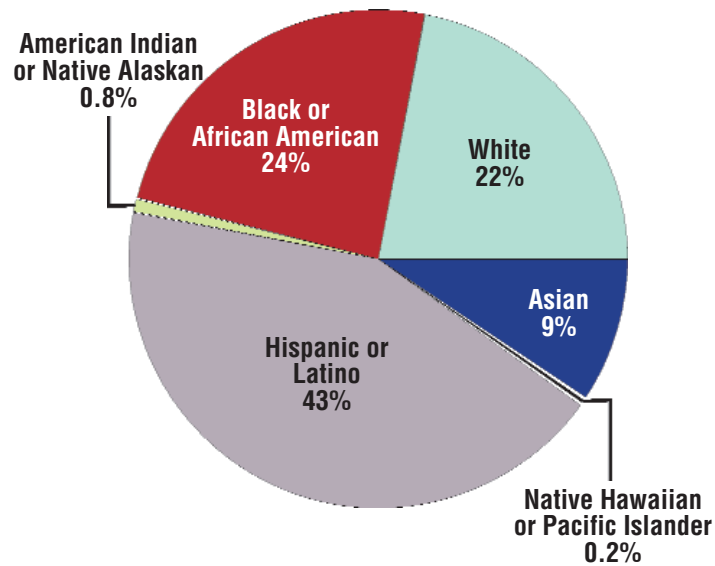

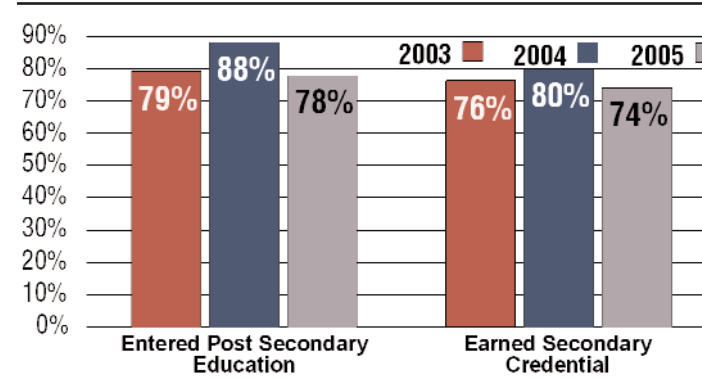

Ethnicity of Adult Education Students - 2005

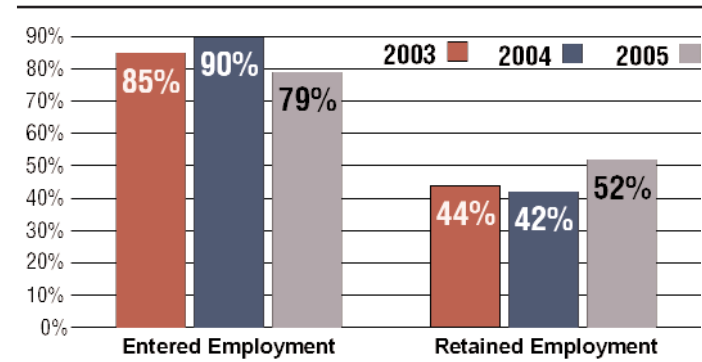

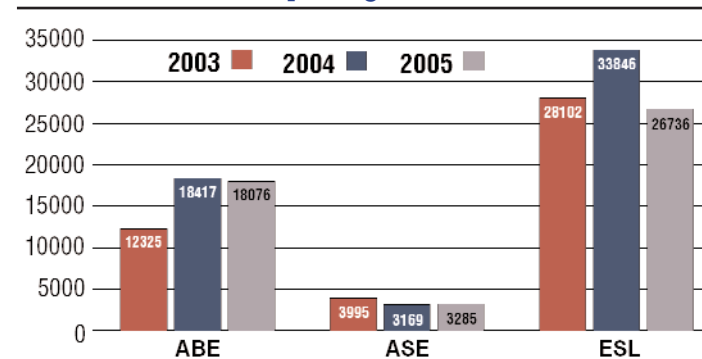

Joined the Workforce

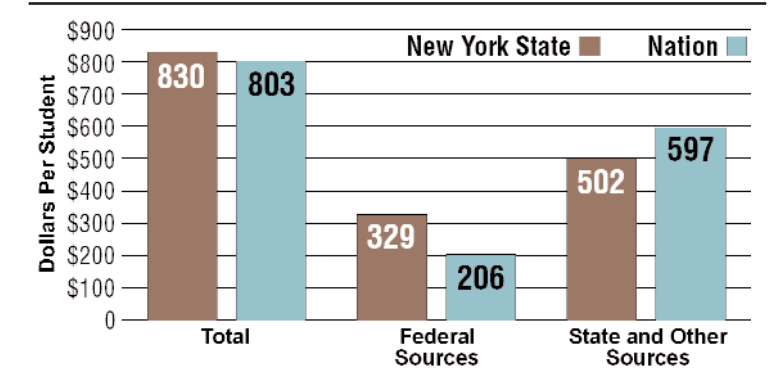


Students Completing One or More Levels

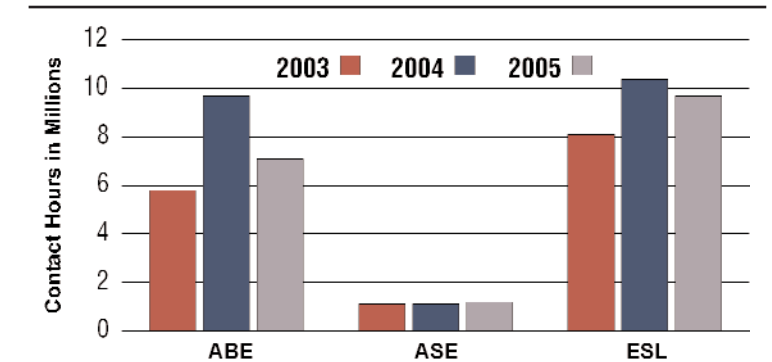


# Enrollment and Class Time
